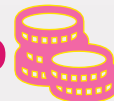


TEAM BPS

Weekly fun runs at Pilrig Park will start in March 2019. The Sunday catch up is a great chance to meet children from other classes and help everyone feel confident and ready for the races. It is very relaxed. We play games, walk/run round the park and then hang out at the swing park. Families tell us it's a brilliant way to meet others, as sometimes the drop off and pick up routine doesn't always give us the time to chat and make friends as parents. The 4 children's races are all held on **Saturday 25th May 2019. Entry fee is £10.30 per child + admin fee. Junior 5K is £17.55 + admin fee**

1k (1.00pm):	3-6 years (suitable for Nursery and P1 & P2)
1.5k (1.45pm):	6-8 years
2k (2.30pm):	9-12 years
Junior 5k (11.45am):	11-18 years

The adult races (suitable for parents, carers and teachers) are 5k and 10K: Saturday 25th May
Half Marathon, Marathon and Hairy Haggis Relay (4 runners each running one leg to complete the marathon) – Sunday 26th May 2019
