Spelling and math homework will continue to be handed out on a weekly basis.

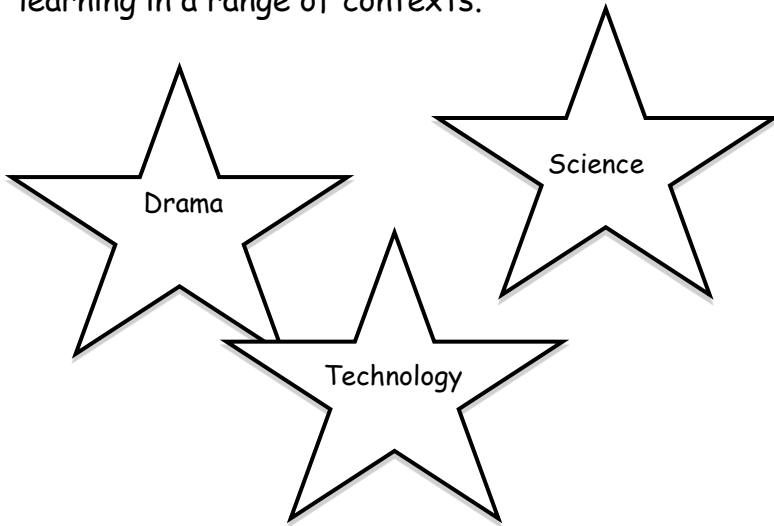
This term, we will be starting the reading for enjoyment challenge. Please encourage your child to keep a record of the books they have read in their reading passport.
