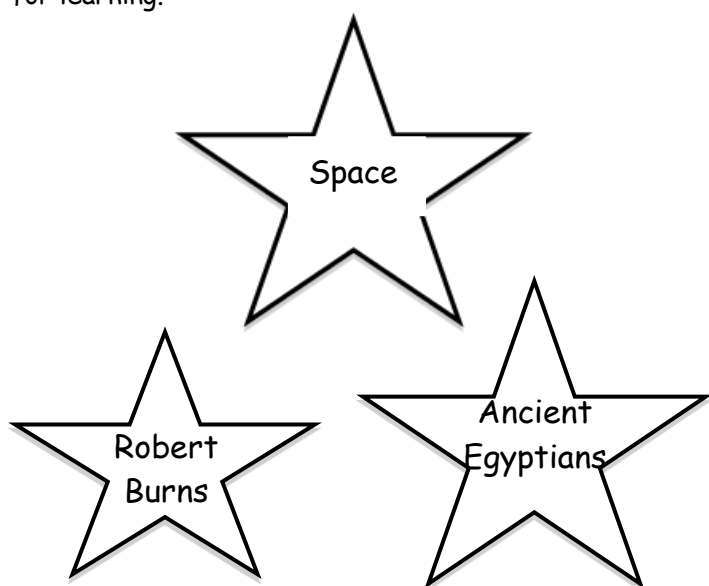

Interdisciplinary Learning

This term P3 are continuing their Space topic before starting with a study of the poet Robert Burns. We will then be learning about the Ancient Egyptians. These topics will allow pupils to develop skills in a variety of curricular areas across the four contexts for learning.



Discrete Subjects

Numeracy -

Both classes will be following the SEAL programme this term. This programme focuses on developing number skills through active learning.

Maths -

We will be covering measurement, time and probability this term.

Writing - This term, we will be developing our poetry and story writing skills. We will also continue to improve our knowledge of verbs, nouns and adjectives.
