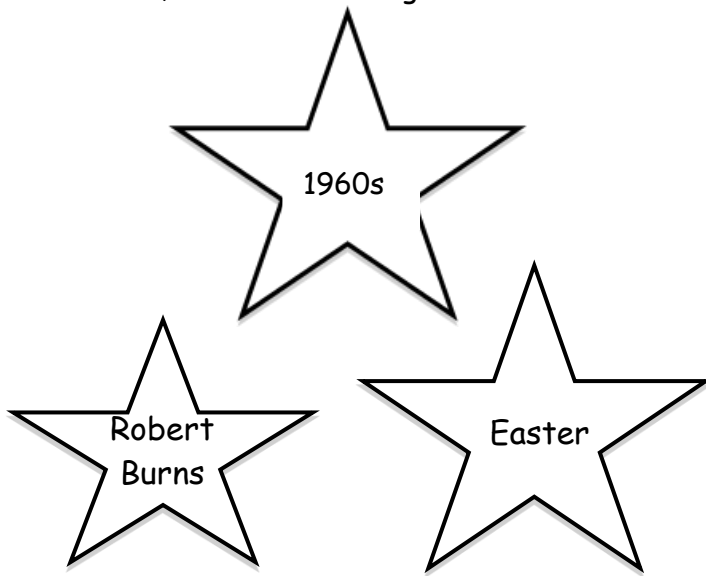

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Interdisciplinary Learning

This term P4A and P4B will be learning about the 1960s as our topic. We will be studying Music, Fashion, Art, Dance and Science from the 1960s and finding out about many other significant historical events from the era. We will also be keeping up to date with national and world days of celebration, such as Burns Night and Easter.



Discrete Subjects

Numeracy -

P4 will be following the SEAL programme this term. This focuses on developing number processes such as addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Maths -

We will be covering fractions, decimals and percentages.

Writing -

This term, the whole school spelling programme will continue. P4 will be developing note-taking skills from media, as well as learning how to write instructions for non-fiction stimuli.

Art -

P4A will have art this term with Mrs Martin and P4B will have art with their class teacher.

HWB - We are continuing to look at our whole school resilience programme, as well as learning about Internet Safety.

Music: Both classes will be learning musical skills this term delivered by a group of specialists who have been working in schools across the city. This will take place on Wednesdays.
