Maths - Broughton Counts - This term our mental maths focus is place value. Our ongoing learning will be shape, angles & fractions.

Literacy - This term we are excited about reading some fantastic books. Keep up the good reading at home! We are also taking part in the Radio 2, 500 word writing competition. The pupils are really enjoying this initiative! Our spelling programme continues to be part of our daily routine.

HWB - We are continuing our Building Resilience programme here at Broughton. The focus for this term will be 'Take a Moment'. The main aim of this unit is to help children to develop the emotional literacy skills they require to navigate their everyday life.

RME - This term we will continue to learn about different world religions and diversity.

Science - This term, pupils will be investigating changes in substances. This will include conducting experiments to determine the solubility of many different substances. Pupils will also be developing their scientific vocabulary throughout these lessons.
