<p><u>Reading</u></p> <p>New reading books will be sent home every Monday and Wednesday.</p> <p>Please send the book into school every day for class reading groups.</p> <p>Cut out and practise the tricky word: go, we, be.</p>	<p><u>Spelling</u></p> <p>Revise all initial sounds and practise as many CVC words as you can with them.</p>	<p><u>Broughton Counts</u></p> <p>We are learning about doubles and near doubles. Make double 1 on your fingers, how many do you have altogether? Add one more, how many do you have now? Repeat for double 2, 3, 4 and 5.</p>

<p><u>Spring</u></p> <p>With an adult go for a walk, what signs of Spring can you spot?</p>	<p><u>Time Travellers</u></p> <p>Can you make your own time capsule? You could include photos, pictures of things that are important to you just now, an example of your drawings or writing.
